**ICE SKATING ASSOCIATION OF IRELAND  
NATIONAL COMPETITION AND CHAMPIONSHIP 2010**

1. The Competition is sanctioned by the Ice Skating Association of Ireland.
2. All entrants **MUST** be a current member of ISAI or Emerald Skate and supply a valid membership number with their Entry Form.
3. All entrants **MUST** be eligible skaters as defined by the Ice Skating Association of Ireland.
4. The Competition will be held in Dundalk IceDome on **Saturday the 8th of MAY 2010**.
5. The ice surface is 59m x 28m, with slightly rounded corners. Location: Dundalk Ice Dome, Dundalk Retail Park, Inner Relief Rd, Dundalk, Ireland.
6. The **closing date** for entries is **18th APRIL 2010**. Please ensure that your entry is posted well before the closing date as proof of postage does **NOT** imply receipt.
7. Late entries will **NOT** be accepted under any circumstances.
8. The qualifying date for **STANDARD** is **18th APRIL 2010**.
9. The qualifying **AGE**, if applicable, is **18th APRIL 2010**, unless otherwise stated.
10. The qualifying age for Championship Events is the as of the 1st of July preceding the Event.
11. Skaters may only compete in an event for which he/she qualifies by standard.
12. In the event a current ISAI member holds tests from the National Ice Skating Association of the UK, and has not had an opportunity to test the equivalent level this year within the ISAI National Test Structure, the following equivalencies will be award for **THIS EVENT ONLY**.

ISAI Novice	Full Level 8 (NISA)
ISAI Junior	Full Level 9 (NISA)
ISAI Senior	Full Level 10 (NISA)
13. Events with large numbers of entries may be split into multiple groups categorised by age.
14. It may be necessary to limit the numbers in some of the events. Should entries be restricted to a competition, this will be done on a first come, first served basis.

15. All entries must be accompanied by the correct fee :
  - 15.1. Free Event €20.00
  - 15.2. Championship Event €40.00
16. **Cheques should be crossed and made payable to ISAI** and included with the completed application form. Please print the competitors name on the reverse of all cheques.
17. Skaters will not be allowed to skate until all fees have been paid. The ISAI take no responsibility for cash or funds lost in transit.
18. The entry fee is **non-refundable** in the event of a competitor withdrawing from the competition after **18th APRIL 2010**.
19. Refunds will only be given under the following conditions:
  - 19.1. An event is not held.
  - 19.2. Withdrawal of an entry is made on or before the official deadline of **18th APRIL 2010**.
20. All entry forms **MUST** include a stamped self addressed envelopes in order to return acceptance, information and time tables to the competitor.
21. All entries **MUST** be submitted on a **COMPLETED** entry form. Any incomplete entry forms received will be returned. Entry into the competition will not be accepted until all information is provided.
22. Entry forms should be **POSTED** to the Competition Coordinator, ISAI, 52 Rathdown Ave, Terenure, Dublin 6W.
23. **NO ENTRY FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED** by the reception staff at Dundalk IceDome.
24. The ISAI reserve the right to refuse entry without reason or to cancel an event, in which case the entry fee will be refunded. The ISAI's Board's **decision is final**.
25. Music must be on CDs and **CLEARLY** marked with the competitor's name and the competition entered. Programme music **MUST** be the only piece of music on the CD.
26. Music must be turned in at the time of official registration and will not be returned until the conclusion of the event.

27. Once turned in, the ISAI will accept no responsibility for breakage, damage or loss of CDs but will take every precaution to ensure their safety. All competitors must have an extra copy of their CD available during the actual competition.
28. The draw for each event will take place prior to the competition and order of skaters will be posted on the official notice board in the ice rink before the competition.
29. The official registration desk will be located at Dundalk Ice Dome attended one hour before the first competitive event. All competitors are required to register as soon as they arrive at the rink. Competition CDs should be turned in at this time.
30. Skaters are to be in the rink and ready to skate 30 minutes before their event is scheduled to begin. Events will not be delayed for skaters who arrive late.
31. Passes will be issued for the skater, their Coach and one chaperone.
32. Only pass holders will be permitted rink side (only Competitors, Coaches and Officials will be allowed unlimited access within the rink area. There will be restricted areas).
33. No viewing will be permitted from the rink side. All spectators must view from the seated balcony area above.
34. All events will be judged using the 6.0 system.
35. The highest placed skater will be 1st, the next highest placed skater, second and so on.
36. Awards will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed skaters.
37. Winners of the Championship event will be entitled to use the title of Irish Novice / Junior / Senior Champion.
38. Winners of ALL other events will be entitled to use the title Gold / Silver / Bronze Medal Winner.
39. Presentations will take place as soon as possible after the last competition.
40. **No flash** photography is allowed during the entire event.
41. All videotaping and photography is restricted to hand-held battery operated equipment, without tripod, and is permissible only in the upper viewing area. No videotaping or photography from rink side. Please be courteous to others viewing the event.

42. Award photos will be taken. We ask that all award winners pose for the group pictures even if you do not plan to purchase a picture.
43. An official bulletin board will be maintained at the competition site. The official schedule showing starting times for each event and the draw will be posted on the bulletin board. The official schedule supersedes all other schedules. Notices posted on this bulletin board are considered as sufficient notice to all competitors.
44. All events will be conducted under the Competition Rules of the ISAI and ISU.
45. This competition is subject to **DOPING CONTROL** as recommended by the International Olympic Committee and the ISU.
46. ISAI will not be liable for any accidents or damage, howsoever caused, to any competitor or to any official appointed by ISAI arising out of or in connection with the activities of ISAI.
