**ICE SKATING ASSOCIATION OF IRELAND
EMERALD SKATE COMPETITION 2010**

1. The Competition is sanctioned by the Ice Skating Association of Ireland.
2. All entrants **MUST** be a current member of ISAI or Emerald Skate and supply a copy of their valid membership card with their Entry Form.
3. All entrants **MUST** be eligible skaters as defined by the Ice Skating Association of Ireland.
4. The Competition will be held in Dundalk IceDome on **Wednesday 17th March 2010**.
5. The ice surface is 59m x 28m, with slightly rounded corners. Location: Dundalk Ice Dome, Dundalk Retail Park, Inner Relief Rd, Dundalk, Ireland.
6. The **closing date** for entries is **1st MARCH 2010**. Please ensure that your entry is posted well before the closing date as proof of postage does **NOT** imply receipt.
7. Late entries will **NOT** be accepted under any circumstances.
8. The qualifying date for **STANDARD** is **1st MARCH 2010**.
9. The qualifying **AGE**, if applicable, is **1st MARCH 2010**, unless otherwise stated.
10. Skaters may only compete in an event for which he/she qualifies by standard.
11. Events with large numbers of entries may be split into multiple groups categorised by age.
12. Emerald Skate Levels 1-3 events may be combined in the case of insufficient entrants.
13. It may be necessary to limit the numbers in some of the events. Should entries be restricted to a competition, this will be done on a first come, first served basis.
14. All entries must be accompanied by the correct fee :

14.1. One Event	€15.00
14.2. Two Event	€25.00
14.3. Three Event	€30.00
15. Cheques should be crossed and made payable to ISAI and included with the completed application form. Please print the competitors name on the reverse of all cheques.

16. Skaters will not be allowed to skate until all fees have been paid. ISAI take no responsibility for cash or funds lost in transit.
17. The entry fee is **non-refundable** in the event of a competitor withdrawing from the competition after **1st MARCH 2010**.
18. Refunds will only be given under the following conditions:
 - 18.1. An event is not held.
 - 18.2. Withdrawal of an entry is made on or before the official deadline of 1st March 2010.
19. All entry forms **MUST** include a stamped self addressed envelopes in order to return acceptance, information and time tables to the competitor.
20. All entries **MUST** be submitted on a **COMPLETED** entry form. Any incomplete entry forms received will be returned. Entry into the competition will not be accepted until all information is provided.
21. Entry forms should be **posted** to the **Competition Coordinator ISAI 52 Rathdown Ave Terenure Dublin 6W**.
22. **No entry form will be accepted** by the reception staff at Dundalk IceDome.
23. The ISAI reserve the right to refuse entry without reason or to cancel an event, in which case the entry fee will be refunded. The ISAI's Board's **decision is final**.
24. Music must be on CDs and **CLEARLY** marked with the competitor's name and the competition entered. Programme music **MUST** be the only piece of music on the CD.
25. Music must be turned in at the time of official registration and will not be returned until the conclusion of the event.
26. Once turned in, the ISAI will accept no responsibility for breakage, damage or loss of CDs but will take every precaution to ensure their safety. All competitors must have an extra copy of their CD available during the actual competition.
27. The draw for all events will take place prior to the competition and order of skaters will be posted both on the official website and in the ice rink before the competition.
28. The official registration desk will be located at Dundalk Ice Dome attended one hour before the first competitive event. All competitors are required to register as soon as they arrive at the rink. Competition CDs should be turned in at this time.

29. Skaters are to be in the rink and ready to skate 60 minutes before their event is scheduled to begin. Events will not be delayed for skaters who arrive late.
30. Passes will be issued for the skater, their Coach and one chaperone.
31. Only pass holders will be permitted rink side (only Competitors, Coaches and Officials will be allowed unlimited access within the rink area. There will be restricted areas).
32. No viewing will be permitted from the rink side. All spectators must view from the seated balcony area above.
33. Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed skaters. The highest marked skater will be awarded 1st
34. Winners will be entitled to use the title Gold / Silver / Bronze Medal Winner.
35. Presentations will take place as soon as possible after the last competition.
36. **No flash** photography is allowed during the entire event.
37. All videotaping and photography is restricted to hand-held battery operated equipment, without tripod, and is permissible only in the upper viewing area. No videotaping or photography from rink side. Please be courteous to others viewing the event.
38. ISAI will have an official photographer present throughout the competition.
39. Award photos will be taken. We ask that all award winners pose for the group pictures even if you do not plan to purchase a picture.
40. An official bulletin board will be maintained at the competition site. The official schedule showing starting times for each event and the draw will be posted on the bulletin board. The official schedule supersedes all other schedules. Notices posted on this bulletin board are considered as sufficient notice to all competitors.
41. This competition is subject to **DOPING CONTROL** as recommended by the International Olympic Committee and the ISU.
42. ISAI will not be liable for any accidents or damage, howsoever caused, to any competitor or to any official appointed by ISAI arising out of or in connection with the activities of ISAI.
43. The competition will be run in accordance with ISU Competition Rules. Any occurrence not covered in this announcement will defer to ISU Regulations.
