



SECTION 200 ELIGIBILITY AND SANCTIONING

201

ISU Rule 102 applies.

202

An eligible person is one who elects to take part only in competitions which are:

1. Sanctioned by the ISAI, any ISU Member and/or the ISU
2. Conducted by ISAI, any ISU Member and/or ISU recognised and approved Officials, including Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Judges, Starters, Competitors Stewards and others; and
3. Conducted under ISAI, any ISU Member and/or the ISU Regulations;

203

A person becomes ineligible to participate in ISAI, any ISU Member and/or ISU activities and competitions by:

1. Skating or officiating without the prior express authorisation of the ISAI, in any capacity in a skating competition, exhibition or tour in any of the sport disciplines of the ISU ;
2. Skating or officiating in a competition conducted by Officials (Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Judges, Starters, Competitors Stewards, etc.) not on the approved list of the ISAI or on the ISU approved list;
3. Skating or officiating in an event not sanctioned by the ISAI, ISU Member and/or the ISU
4. Otherwise violating ISU Rule 102.

204

A skater may receive payments for appearances, endorsements and exhibition performances and still remain eligible, provided:

1. Such skater complies with all conditions established by the ISAI.
2. Payments or other benefits to be received by such skater for any skating appearance are made through the ISAI or at least with full information on such payments or benefits given by such skater to the ISAI.
3. Such skater complies with all other provisions of ISU Rule 102;

205

The ISAI may demand a contribution from the skater up to 10% of such payments in consideration of past and present support of the skater.

206

All ISAI eligible members must comply with all ISU regulations on Trademarks.

207

The ISAI shall monitor their skaters to ensure they remain eligible. It is the responsibility of **the skater** to ensure that they do not participate in competitions or events that would render them ineligible. The ISAI will not intervene on the activities of an individual skater but should their actions contravene these regulations the ISAI will remove their eligibility status.

Restricted Eligibility : in addition to ISU restrictions on eligibility, a remunerated coach may not be a Referee, Assistant Referee, Technical Controller, or Judge in competitions held under ISAI rules.

209

ISU Rule 200 applies in the reinstatement of an eligible person.

210

All competitions held by **affiliated** clubs under ISAI rules shall be considered to be sanctioned by the ISAI. However, a copy of the competition announcement must be forwarded to the Technical Committee for verification. All regulations must be met or the sanction will be withdrawn.

211

All other competitions held by **affiliated** clubs which do not involve participation of skaters or officials from another ISU Member country, shall be considered to be sanctioned by the ISAI. However, a copy of the competition announcement must be forwarded to the Technical Committee for verification. All regulations must be met or the sanction will be withdrawn.

212

All competitions for Emerald Skate members held by any organisation or persons involved in the Emerald Skate program shall be considered to be sanctioned by the ISAI. However, a copy of the competition announcement must be forwarded to the Technical Committee for verification. All regulations must be met or the sanction will be withdrawn.

213

All competitions held by any organisation or persons or clubs under ISAI rules **MUST** apply to the ISAI for sanction.

214

All ice shows, demonstrations and other events within Ireland not involving competition or judging **MUST** apply to the ISAI for an Exhibition Permit.

215

All ice shows, demonstrations and other events held outside Ireland not involving competition or judging **MUST** hold the equivalent permit by the ISU Member of the country it is held in.

216

Eligible persons have the permission of the ISAI to participate only in ISAI sanctioned events.

217

Eligible persons should not participate along side ineligible persons.

218

Participation in an unsanctioned event may result in the participant becoming ineligible.

**219**

Eligible persons who receive payment or benefits in kind for activities involving skating should apply for Retained Eligibility and authorisation prior to receipt of such payments; failure to do so may result in loss of eligibility.

220

Retained Eligible persons who receive payment or benefits in kind for activities involving skating activity must submit an annual income report. Failure to do so may result in loss of eligibility.

221

Retained Eligible persons who receive payment from coaching activities must submit an annual income report. Failure to do so may result in loss of eligibility.

222

All officials participating in sanctioned events shall be considered to be on ISAI approved list of officials for the duration of the competition.
